The house is made of several green materials including recycled concrete siding and several solar panels on the roof. The windows are strategically placed to allow maximum sunlight into the house. The massive window from the kitchen looking out onto the deck is not only aesthetically pleasing but it allows for a warm environment in the kitchen area as well. The house is only one floor but is very well spaced inside which allows for a lot of open areas. It is an open floor plan which creates a good flow throughout the house. I changed the slope and shape of the garage roof to take away from drainage problems that I recognized, and also repositioned some solar panels so they will receive maximum sunlight exposure. In addition I spaced the garage doors better so it is now a three car garage. I also changed the deck a little so that the stairs are wider, and also repositioned the large kitchen window. The rooms are very large and I think the house would suit the area very well as a whole. It is a modernized house with green materials and an open, easy floor plan.
